### **CONTRACT SIGNING OF CABLE LAY BARGE CONVERSION**

Singapore — A contract had been signed with Prysmian Powerlink Services Limited (UK) for the major conversion of an existing ballastable flat top barge into a converted mooring system positioned cable lay barge manned by 57 persons at PaxOcean Singapore yard.

After conversion, the vessel will have an eight point positional mooring system, a new 5-tier accommodation block incorporating a power generation room on lowest level, 3 levels of accommodation for 57 persons in 30 cabins, and a control room on top level. The Cable Lay Barge will be capable of transporting and loading 7,000 tonnes of cable in a 30 m diameter Carousel, and be equipped with Carousel loading pick-up arm, a stern mounted cable chute for loading and surface lay, cable tensioner, a 10 ton deck crane and a 3 ton stores crane and 4 units Caterpillar Acert C32 Diesel Generators and an Emergency Generator.

The vessel is expected to be re-delivered end May 2016.
